**ATTORNEY GENERAL FILES CONSUMER PROTECTION SUIT
AGAINST JOHNSON COUNTY COMPANY**

Attorney General Phill Kline today filed suit against a Johnson County company that promotes science fiction conventions across the nation for alleged violations of the Kansas Consumer Protection Act.

Slanted Fedora Entertainment and its owners, Jackie and David Scott of Shawnee, KS, have been sued for allegedly engaging in 27 transactions that violate the Kansas Consumer Protection Act. These alleged violations involve consumers from all over the country. The company faces civil fines and penalties up to \$10,000 for each transaction found to be in violation of the KCPA.

The suit, filed in Johnson County District Court, alleges that the company has repeatedly cancelled conventions without refunding consumers deposits, double charged credit and debit cards, and promoted speakers that did not show up at the conventions.

The company was previously ordered by the court to shut down its website prompting them to refund monies to many consumers who had filed complaints with the Kansas Attorney General and the Better Business Bureau of Kansas City, MO.

The Kansas Attorney General, in conjunction with the BBB, is currently investigating complaints against this company from consumers across the country.
